What/Who is Youthworks?

For over 25 years, YouthWorks has partnered with communities and churches to provide impactful mission experiences for youth. YouthWorks organizes service opportunities, provides trained Summer Staff on-site and organizes lodging and meals during our stay.

What will we do during our mission trip?

During a week in Benton Harbor, our group will partner with local organizations to serve the city across age and racial divides. In the evenings, our group will tour the community and learn about the fine arts revitalization in Benton Harbor from a community friend. You'll also have the opportunity to experience local BBQ, visit a Lake Michigan beach, and explore Benton Harbor's sister city, St. Joseph. YouthWorks has partnered with this community since 2000.

Where will we stay?

YouthWorks provides housing and meals at a local church and shower facilities at a local community center.

What's covered in the cost?

Program fees, most food, lodging, transportation, recreational outings. It does not cover meals on the road and souvenirs.



Will we do anything else?

Yes! Other experiences may include a ferry ride across Lake Michigan, a stop in Wisconsin Dells on the way home, a beach day, etc.

Will fundraising be available?

Yes, we are working on ways to help make this an affordable trip for all youth. We hope to raise enough to cover the cost of half of the trip (making the cost closer to \$325). Scholarships are also available. Please reach out to Erin for scholarship information.
