MONTANA ADVENTURE TRIP GLACIER/FLATHEAD



What/Who/Where is Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp?

After gauging the interests and considerations of Resurrection youth and families, it has been decided that our summer 2026 trip will be an adventure trip to Montana. Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp is an ELCA camp situated in the majestic Rocky Mountains of western Montana, about 40 miles southwest of Glacier National Park. Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp offers a Christ-centered camping and adventure experience for people of all ages. The staff is trained to help youth understand God's message of grace and to provide positive Christian role models while having an amazing experience in God's great outdoors!

What will we do during our trip?

During the week in Montana, our group will explore God's creation in fun and exciting ways. Our days may consist of a half-day white-water trip, an overnight kayaking trip near the Canadian border, hiking the mountains, rock climbing, and exploring Glacier National Park. Each day will also include community building, worship, exploring the Bible, and discussing our faith. We will be challenged spiritually and mentally through this experience while building great relationships with one another.

How will we get there? Where will we stay?

If it remains in the budget, we hope to take the Amtrak from St. Paul to Whitefish, MT. We will be closely monitoring this cost as registrations come in. If it does not remain in our budget, we will drive to/from Montana and make an overnight stop on each leg of the trip to rest. FLBC provides lodging and meals on its site. Their site includes weather-proof huts, bathrooms, a shower house, and other camp amenities.
